ACC Transfer Student Intent Survey

- Online survey administered to ACC students enrolled in the Spring 2020 semester
- Survey open from 4/30 to 5/10
- Response rate 12.2%
 - Invitations sent to 17,375 students enrolled in gateway courses
 - 2,138 responses received



- 92% have considered or thought about transferring to a four-year
- 74.2 % responded "very likely" they will transfer
- The two schools with the highest percent responding that they are the first choice for transfer to a four year are:
 - Texas State University (29.5%) and
 - The University of Texas at Austin (30.9%)

- 54.3% plan on earning an associate degree before transferring
- 75.7% responded "strongly agree" or "agree" to lining up their ACC coursework to conform to requirements for their major at the transfer institution
- 61.0% stated "yes" they were following a transfer guide or agreement for a particular school
- 43.4% stated that yes the COVID-19 has caused them to modify plans to transfer



Top three ways students have modified plans:

• 39.2% responded (strongly agree or agree) that they are going to spend more time taking courses at ACC before transferring

• 36.6% responded (strongly agree or agree) that they decided to take fewer courses

• 32.8% (strongly agree or agree) they had delayed the semester when plan to attend the transfer institution

 Top three factors that might prevent students from attending a four-year college:

• 63.9% responded (strongly agree or agree) that the higher cost of tuition and fees at the four-year college or university

- 42.4% responded (strongly agree or agree) not getting accepted
- 40.5% responded (strongly agree or agree) loans and personal debt

 Top three aspects of the transfer process ACC students need help with:

• 79.2% responded (strongly agree or agree) learning about program-specific admission policies at four-year colleges and universities

• 75.1% responded (strongly agree or agree) learning about four-year college and university admission policies


• 73.9% responded (strongly agree or agree) completing the application to transfer to a four-year college or university





















Q13: How many major-specific courses have you completed (excluding General Education courses like English 1301, Math 1314, etc.)?












